The Town of Halton Hills invites you to attend a Statutory Public Meeting to discuss a proposed Housekeeping Amendment to the Town of Halton Hills' Comprehensive Zoning By-law, 2010-0050.

The purpose of this exercise is to make several housekeeping, technical and other modifications affecting all zones or site-specific regulations to assist in the use and interpretation of the Zoning By-law, and to correct grammar, punctuation, and formatting (administrative focused).

The Public Meeting will give the community and stakeholders an opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on the proposed amendment.

The Housekeeping Amendment applies to the entire Town and therefore there is no map provided. A copy of the staff report and related amendment will be available on May 16th, 2025 on the Town's website at [haltonhills.ca/calendars](https://haltonhills.ca/calendars).

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect to the Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills – Planning and Development Department at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

Legal Notices Required under the Planning Act:

1. If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of Town of Halton Hills Council to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.
2. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
