1. CALL TO ORDER

4. SCHEDULED ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

a. Official Plan Review

M. Ricci presented to the Committee on the Official Plan Review with information on the 5 phases of the project and the current Official Plan. M. Ricci discussed the results from the public open house and reviewed the key findings of the background report.

The Committee participated in an engagement activity related to the key priorities for the Official Plan Review.

b. Bike Repair Station Replacement

I. Drewnitski reviewed locations of bike repair stations that need replacement, which included the Gellert Community Centre and the Acton Library.

G. Price-Jones noted that tools at some of the newer repair stations are starting to rust and suggested looking at cost of stainless-steel tools. Staff to look into this further.

Councillor J. Fogal suggested looking at having shelters over the bike repair stations or using existing infrastructure such as gazebos.

The Committee discussed a potential location for an additional bike repair station.

Recommendation No. ACT-2025-007

THAT a new bike repair station be installed at Dominion Gardens Park.

Price-Jones advised that during a Bike It group ride safety concerns were noted on the multi-use path on Armstrong Avenue near the Strictly Dance building as well as the Racquet Club building. It was suggested that signage should be added in that area to bring attention to the multi-use path. I. Drewnitski will look into these concerns further with staff.
